The Rebirth Brass Band is a New Orleans brass band. The Band was recently featured in Spike Lee's 2006 documentary "When The Levees Broke: A Requiem In Four Acts," a series that examined the tragedy of hurricane Katrina. Rebirth is known for combining traditional New Orleans brass band music, including the New Orleans tradition of second line with funk, jazz, and soul influences.

They also play booming up tempo tunes, spirituals, rags, marching numbers, and originals, doing them all with a traditional feel and contemporary sensibility. Their signature brand of heavy funk has placed them among the world's top brass bands and they are the hands-down favorite among the younger generation. The band regularly tours in North America and Europe, second only to the Dirty Dozen Brass Band in popularity and acclaim among the brass bands of New Orleans.
